





The residence captures the clients' desire for a space that balances social engagement with personal seclusion. The result is a luxurious and livable home, reminiscent of a five-star retreat, with refined furnishings and carefully selected art pieces.



Blurring the Line Between Landscape and Architecture

One of the home's unique features is its integration into the surrounding desert landscape. Situated on a narrow plot of land bordered by a hill, the property incorporates elements of the excavated terrain into its design. Stone retaining walls and pillars seamlessly blend with the natural environment, leading visitors to a grand entrance marked by massive bronze doors and a landscaped path.






The home's interior flows effortlessly into the outdoor space, with landscaped decks offering panoramic views of both the Las Vegas strip and the untouched desert. Terraced outdoor dining areas, a bocce ball court, and a pool area complete with fire pits provide ample space for family gatherings and outdoor living.









The design features an H-shaped layout that separates personal retreats from guest accommodations. This thoughtful organization allows for an entire wing of the house to be closed off when not in use, balancing function with energy efficiency. At the heart of the home, Chenin's use of 'portals' creates framed transitions between spaces, giving the residence a cinematic flow.









Throughout, the home's spaces are meticulously crafted to elevate daily living. From the marble-clad bathrooms to the luxurious bedrooms featuring custom-designed furniture, every room reflects Chenin's immersive design philosophy, which he describes as the "discovery of nuance."



A Showcase of Luxury Furnishings and Art

The home's interior design merges classical and modern aesthetics, deconstructed and reinterpreted to create a timeless space. Chenin incorporated a blend of custom-designed pieces alongside iconic furnishings from Poltrona Frau, Holly Hunt, and Knoll, among others.
